## 2010 Australian Championship Format

### FRIDAY – 5<sup>th</sup> March 2010

<b>10am to 3pm</b>	Scrutineering - Times to be allocated for teams and will be notified 2 weeks prior to the race.
<b>4pm to 8pm</b>	Practice
<b>8pm to 9.30pm</b>	Calcutta

**\* Grid draws to be done on Friday night at Calcutta**

### SATURDAY - 6<sup>th</sup> March 2010

<b>11am to 2pm</b>	Scrutineering - Times to be allocated for teams and will be notified 2 weeks prior to the race.
<b>4pm to 4.30pm</b>	Drivers Briefing - Drivers must be in race suits
<b>4.30pm</b>	Track Packing - Bonus Points to be allocated when cars pack more than 8 laps on transponders.

**\*PLEASE NOTE - No Hot laps tonight as we don't have the time\***

<b>5.00pm</b>	1st Round of Heats over 12 laps – 12 cars per heat
<b>6pm Main program</b>	2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> rounds of heats per car over 12 laps – 12 cars per heat
<b>Prelim A- Main</b>	Top 18 cars to run a Prelim A-Main over 20 laps and points to count (All other cars that don't qualify for the Prelim A-Main will receive 9 points)

## **SUNDAY – 7<sup>th</sup> March 2010**

<b>4pm to 4.30pm</b>	Drivers Briefing - All drivers must be in race suits
<b>4.30pm</b>	Track Packing - Bonus Points to be allocated when cars pack more than 8 laps on transponders
<b>5.15pm</b>	Hot Laps
<b>6pm Main Program</b>	4 <sup>th</sup> round of heats per car over 12 laps - 12 cars per heat
<b>D-Main</b>	12 Laps - Qualifiers 50 to 70 (Top 4 transfers to the C-Main)
<b>C-Main</b>	15 Laps - Qualifiers 34 to 49 (Top 4 transfers to the B-Main)
<b>Dash 1</b>	6 Laps - Qualifiers 9 to 16 (Determine starting positions 9 through to 16 in the A-Main)
<b>Dash 2</b>	6 Laps - Qualifiers 1 to 8 (Determine starting positions 1 through to 8 in the A-Main)
<b>B-Main</b>	20 Laps - Qualifiers 17 to 33 (Top 4 to transfer to A-Main in positions 17 to 20)

### **2010 Australian Wingless Sprint Championship**

35 Laps - Qualifiers 1 through to 16 (Starting positions have been determined from finishing positions in Dashes 1 and 2)

**After 2010 Australian Championship race the top 5 cars to be weighed with drivers in car and then cars to be impounded for engine checks.**

**Presentations to done on infield after cars have been weighed.**

## Meeting Format

### **Nomination Fee:**

A Nomination fee of \$100 is payable and must be paid with a completed nomination form before nomination is accepted.

Late Nomination of \$250 must be paid if nomination has not been received by the 8<sup>th</sup> of February 2010.

### **Track Packing:**

All drivers are required for wheel packing cars must complete more than 8 laps. If a driver completes more than 8 laps on the transponder in wheel packing they will receive 8 bonus points each night.

Please note if drivers are required to complete more laps and are instructed to stay on the track and they don't the bonus points will be removed.

### **Grid Draw:**

On the Friday night at the Calcutta the first two rounds will be drawn and inverted by drawn numbers out of hat.

The final 2 rounds of heats we will also be drawn and invert by drawn numbers out of the hat at the Calcutta.

### **Heat Races:**

Each car will contest a total of four heat races of 12 laps of duration with a max of 12 cars per heat.

### **Heat Points:**

Scoring of heats shall be 22, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, and 2.

### **Saturday Night Prelim A Main:**

Top 18 cars will run in a Prelim A Main grid positions will be determined by the points only from the first 3 heat rounds.

No reserves will be used in the case of a complete rerun.

**Points** - 18-car field: 18, 17.5, 17, 16.5, 16, 15.5, down to 9.5 for 18th place.

All other competitors to receive 9 points.

**If any drivers are tied on points to qualify for the Prelim A-Main on the Friday night it will invert back the fastest lap time over the first 3 heats.**

### **Sunday Night Mains:**

Grid Positions will be made up from the total points from all 4 heats and Prelim A-Main from Saturday night.

### **Tied Points:**

If points are tied for any positions it will invert back to the fastest lap time of the drivers involved in the tied points over the 4 heats of racing only.

D-Main: Will be raced over 12 Laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 50 to 70.  
The first 4 place getters will transfer to the C-Main

C-Main: Will be raced over 15 Laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 34 to 49.  
The first 4 place getters will transfer to the B-Main

B-Main: Will be raced over 20 Laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 17 to 33.  
\*The first 4 place getters will transfer to the A-Main

Dash 1: Will be raced over 6 laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 9 to 16 and start in that order.  
The Finishing order will make up starting positions 9 to 16 in the A-Main

Dash 2: Will be raced over 6 laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 1 to 8 and start in that order.  
The Finishing order will make up starting positions 1 to 8 in the A-Main

### **2010 Australian Championship Race:**

Will be raced over 35 Laps  
Will be made up from Qualifiers 1 to 16.  
Starting positions are made up from finishing positions from Dash 1 and Dash 2. Positions 17 to 20 will be made up from the B-Main.  
Positions 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> from the B-Main will be reserves for the Championship Race in the case of a complete rerun.

**\*Please note if the current Australia 1 doesn't qualify for A-Main they will get an automatic start at the rear of field, if this does happen only the first 3 place getters from the B-Main will transfer through to the A-Main and the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> from the B-Main will become the reserves for the A-Main.**

### **Transponders:**

All cars must have transponders on their cars at all times. Transponders will be available to hire at a fee to be confirmed closer to the event. Hire fee must be paid at scrutineering.

Transponders are to be collect from the AWSR and must be returned at the end of each nights racing.
